

Welcome: President Shawn Funkhouser welcomed all and we had a short discussion about some car activities before we got into the regular agenda. This time also gives us a chance to identify any topics we might want to talk about that maybe were not on the agenda.

HISTORY HAPPENS

At our February, 2016 Club meeting we decided we would add a history article to our newsletter under the heading "History Happens." This article is about being involved with something when you were young that you thought you lost forever but found later in life. We are not sure about the copyright so we need to reference portions of the article and provide proper credits.

THE SAGA OF A CORVAIR DUNE BUGGY BY RICK NORRIS (CORVAIR ALLEY.COM)

Rick Norris is a long time Corvair enthusiast. He was one of the original members of The Corvair Society of America, or CORSA. He was a member of the first Board of Directors and was elected the first National President in 1971. He also attended the first National Convention in Chicago.

His article describes a buggy originally built by some kids in Nitro, West Virginia. The body was a copy of a Meyers

Manx done by a guy in St. Albans by the name of George Smolens. It originally had a turbo motor from a 1963 Corvair Spyder without the turbo and the dash was also used. Rick's old friend Mike Stone found the buggy for sale and bought it. He immediately disassembled the buggy and began reengineering, redesigning and reassembling it. Rick took the engine home and swapped the turbo heads, added some headers and began autocrossing it.

The buggy eventually went to Charlotte, NC, when Rick moved there, and came back to Charleston, WV, when Rick moved back three years later. After moving back to West Virginia, Rick put a '65 coupe autocrosser engine in the buggy. Later on, Mike and Rick sold the buggy to another autocrosser who sold it to some kids and

it disappeared and Rick never thought he would see it again.

In September 1993, Rick was at the annual Golden Oldies Labor Day Car Show at the state Capitol in Charleston. After getting set up at the car show, Rick asked his wife to watch the car so he could walk around and look at the other cars. He happened to see a red dune buggy and getting closer he thought, "This is like the one Mike and I had." He saw it had a Corvair front suspension and engine but was looking for something that would positively identify it, which was a piece of aluminum sheet metal over the oil cooler and a fuel pump boss plug he had made from a bolt and an old pump. Rick found his old dune buggy! Rick went to get his camera and when he came back to take photos he found Mike Stone at the buggy. They remembered the good times they had with the buggy and were glad to see it had survived the years and was still appreciated and looked after. The buggy was all Corvair, except for the gas tank, which is from a Volkswagen, the flip up gas cap, which is from a Corvette, and the tail lights from a '65 Mustang.

A little later, the current owner, Mark Hicks, joined Rick and Mike. Rick told him about the history of the buggy. Rick promised Mark pictures, gave him his card and told him if he ever wanted to sell it, he wanted first refusal. Who knows, it may come home yet. Rick is still waiting to hear from Mark.

TECH TIPS

EARLY MODEL CORVAIR A/C BLOWER NOT WORKING

Per Corvair Center poster, Craig Nicol, the early model Corvair air conditioner has an in line fuse in the gray wire running horizontally above the evaporator on a factory installation. It would be a non working A/C puzzle if one did not know about it. Factory A/C was not available on the Spyders.

ANOTHER TRICKY EARLY A/C NOTE

Per Corvair Center poster "Junkman" there is a yellow wire coming from the high beam switch that prevents the blower motor from going to full speed when the high beams are on. [Ed note] If so, a bad headlight switch could cause the A/C blower problem. Might want to question this one as no one denied or confirmed this post. A check of the early A/C wiring diagram shows a yellow wire but not the headlight switch.





Directions to the club meeting at:

Vandalia Justice Center -

Coming from the east the Justice Center is just down the side road from the Wendy's restaurant that is located on Rt-40 just west of the Vandalia exit from I-70. This side road at Wendy's is James Bohanan Dr. The street address of the justice center is 245 Bohanan Dr. From the west turn left at the BP station turn right on J.E. Bohanan Dr. The Justice Center door is on the east side of the building. Go in the side door and through the door to the dispatch center. The meeting room is to the left past the dispatcher. A public parking lot is available at the corner of James E. Bohanon Dr. and Maple St. behind the bank and some street parking is available. Note: The room is on the west side of the building. If some of the club members are already there you may be able to enter through the side door to the room. They can let you in or may have the door blocked open.

Vandalia Historical Society Meeting House/Shelter -It is only 2 minutes from the Justice Center. It is located at 336 East Alkaline Springs Road. From the Justice Center (or I-75) drive west on National Road to the Dixie Drive Highway intersection. Turn left (south) onto Dixie Drive and continue on Dixie to the stoplight at Elva Court then continue on Dixie to the next street on your left (just past the Vandalia-Butler High School), and turn left (east) onto East Alkaline Springs Road. You will see the City Art Park on your right and just past the park is a long wood picket fence in front of the Society property. Turn right into the driveway and drive back around the barn to the parking area and the Meeting House / Shelter. There are restrooms in the Meeting House if needed. It would be a good idea to bring your mask for that additional step of protection.
