BACKUP LIGHT SWITCH FOR MANUAL TRANSMISSION

The following is a discussion on the Corvair Center Forum about replacing a late model manual transmission backup light switch for a Corvair. The original post called it a "reverse brake light switch".

There should be a 3/8" ball bearing ahead of the switch. Make sure that it doesn't try to make a run for it when you look the other way. Make sure there is one inside the cover because that would keep the switch from working. Be careful when removing the connect because they can be very hard after all of these years and pull out the switch pins if not.

Not trying to hijack. My reverse lights don't work either. I changed my switch, but don't remember a ball bearing. Do you literally just shove a 3/8" ball bearing in the hole and screw the switch in on top of it? The answer was YES.

66-69 style switches used the ball bearing. They were located in the side cover.

61-65 style switches were mounted on the bottom front of the trans. and just used the plunger on the switch. They also needed a close to factory thickness washer or the contacts wouldn't close when shifted into reverse to turn on the back up lights.

Powerglide cars used the neutral safety switch to operate reverse lights.

EARLY MODEL FRONT STABILIZER (SWAY) BAR

Originally the Corvair came without a front sway bar. In 1962 they came as part of a heavy duty suspension option and standard on the Corvair Spyder. In 1964 and after all Corvairs had a front sway bar. According to Clarks catalog for sway bar bushings, there is a different part number for 62-63 and 64-69. Addition of the front bar increases under steer which offsets some of the tendency for oversteer with the engine in the rear. If you can't find a factory bar you can get one from ADDCO. The sway bar will help handling for spirited driving. ADDCO Sway Bars still lists sway bars and link kits for 62-64 Corvairs.









Directions to the club meeting at:

Vandalia Justice Center -

Coming from the east the Justice Center is just down the side road from the Wendy's restaurant that is located on Rt-40 just west of the Vandalia exit from I-70. This side road at Wendy's is James Bohanan Dr. The street address of the justice center is 245 Bohanan Dr. From the west turn left at the BP station turn right on J.E. Bohanan Dr. The Justice Center door is on the east side of the building. Go in the side door and through the door to the dispatch center. The meeting room is to the left past the dispatcher. A public parking lot is available at the corner of James E. Bohanon Dr. and Maple St. behind the bank and some street parking is available. Note: The room is on the west side of the building. If some of the club members are already there you may be able to enter through the side door to the room. They can let you in or may have the door blocked open.

Vandalia Historical Society Meeting House/Shelter -

It is only 2 minutes from the Justice Center. It is located at 336 East Alkaline Springs Road. From the Justice Center (or I-75) drive west on National Road to the Dixie Drive Highway intersection. Turn left (south) onto Dixie Drive and continue on Dixie to the stoplight at Elva Court then continue on Dixie to the next street on your left (just past the Vandalia-Butler High School), and turn left (east) onto East Alkaline Springs Road. You will see the City Art Park on your right and just past the park is a long wood picket fence in front of the Society property. Turn right into the driveway and drive back around the barn to the parking area and the Meeting House / Shelter. There are restrooms in the Meeting House if needed. It would be a good idea to bring your mask for that additional step of protection.
